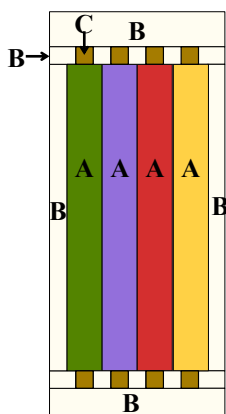
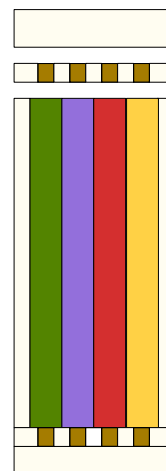


**Block #2  
Fabric Bolts**



4. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top of the  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and a  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the bottom.
5. Sew a  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the block.
6. The finished block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ ".



**Cutting Instructions**

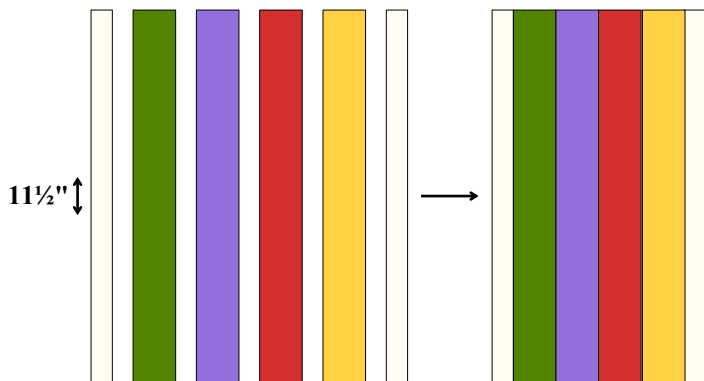
**A: (fabric bolts)** 1 –  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " from  
4 different fabrics

**B: (background)** 2 –  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ "  
2 –  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ "  
2 – 2" x 3"  
3 –  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"

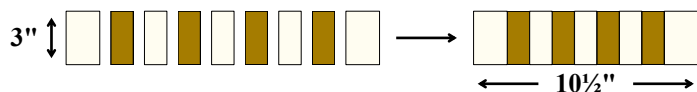
**C: (tops and bottoms of bolts)** 8 –  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"

**Sewing Instructions**

1. Sew the  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together as shown below. The finished rectangle should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ".



2. Sew the 3" strips together as shown below. The rectangle should measure 3" x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



3. Trim the rectangle to make 2 –  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
